SUPERIOR 1:1200 "NEVER-WERES" REISSUES

A126 \$34.50 **TILLMAN**, U.S. BB late 1900's Design
15-18" (5 x 3), 21-6", 4-2" AA,
4 21"TT, 80,000T, 975'L, 25K;

Named after Senator Ben "Pitchfork" Tillman, Secretary of the Senate Naval Affairs committee; He suggested in 1912 that instead of making incremental advances in BB sizes, that the biggest ship possible be built that would fit through the Panama Canal and could use current naval bases. This monster would have dwarfed any existing foreign BB but by the time this design was ready to go, the Washington Naval Treaty doomed it. But what a ship she would have been!

A202 \$32.50 **LEXINGTON**, U.S. 1921 CC Design
43,500T, 874'L, 8-16", 16-6", 8-5".

This Battlecruiser design had a long conceptual stage interrupted by WWI and then cancelled by the Washington Treaty. They were designed as scouts to overwhelm screens of light ships. Because of improvements in boiler and machinery designs, the 1921 version would have been able to function with five stacks instead of seven as planned earlier.

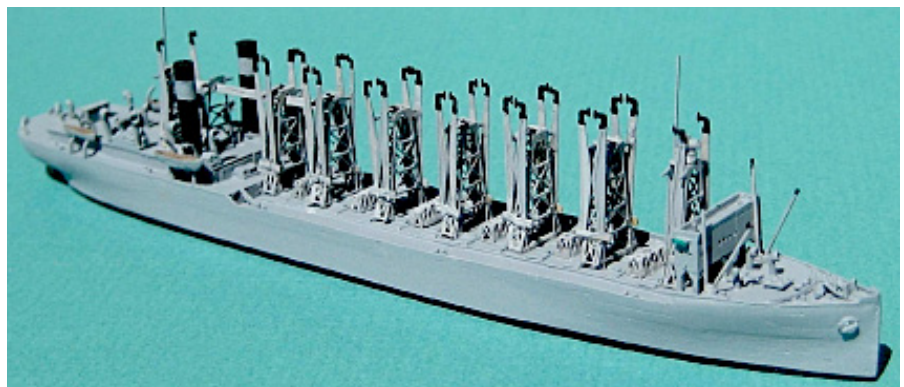

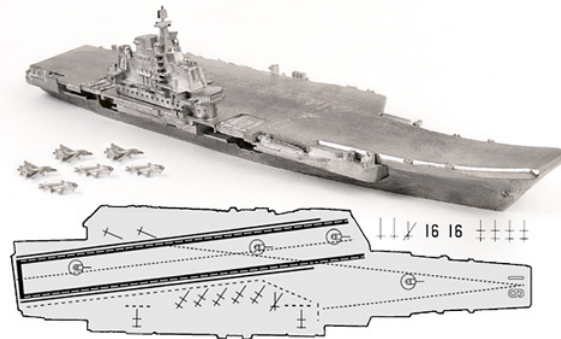

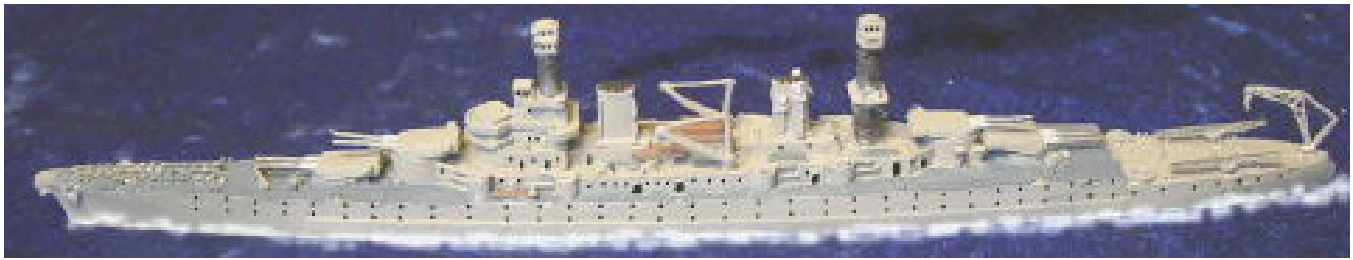

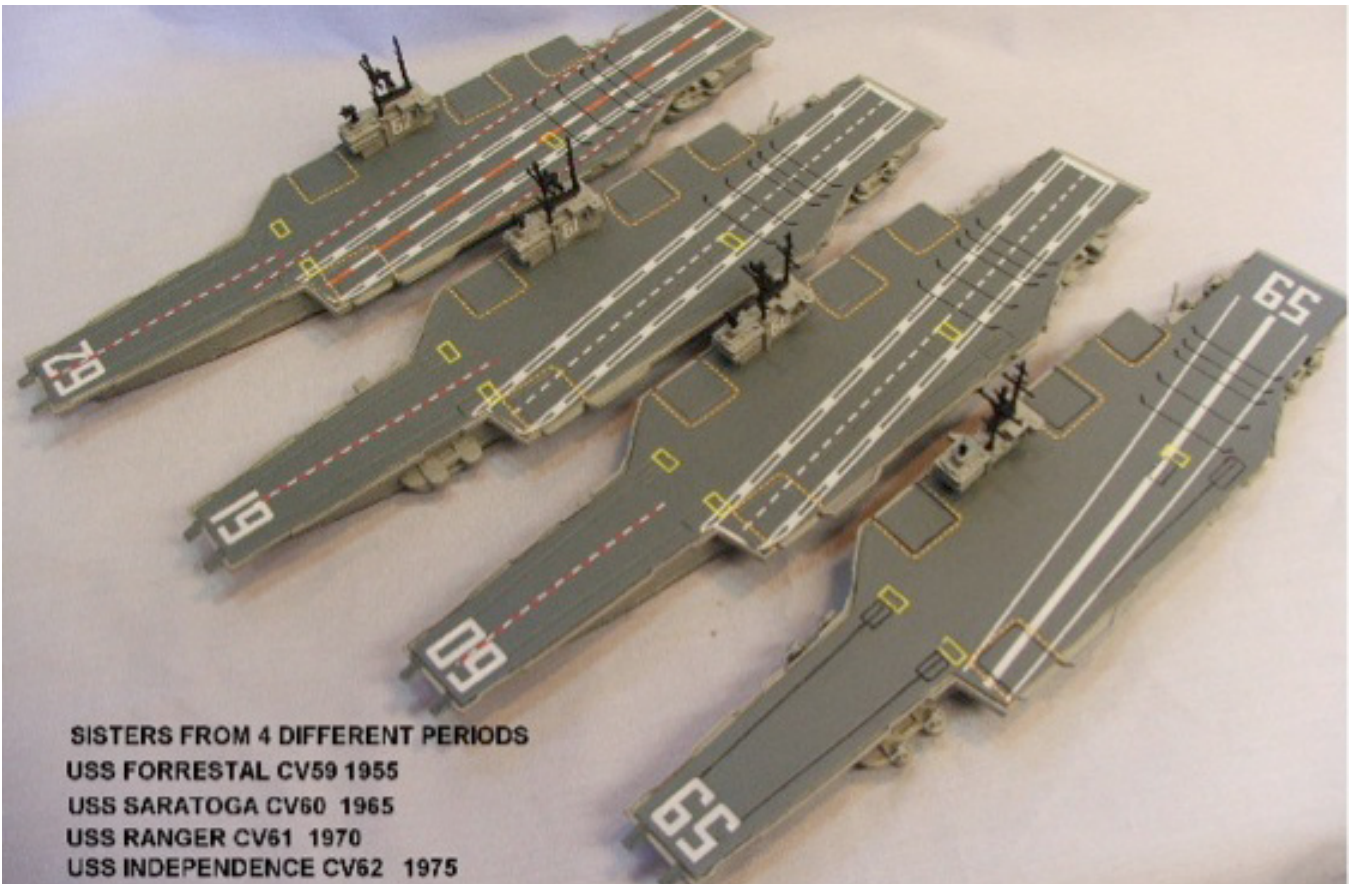
