These are incredibly beautiful, minutely and accurately detailed models. They come to you completely assembled and hand-painted in battleship gray. (See pages 2 & 4 for quick examples). Note that 1:1250 scale in the metric equivalent of 1:1200 (1"=100"), the international recognition scale. This line is considered by many to be the best of its kind in the world. The models are manufactured in Germany. This company also makes the
